

















Economy of Africa is growing faster than 4 other Continents

North (7 Countries): Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Mauritania, Morocco, Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic and Tunisia











Africa's Infrastructure Needs

- General Development of in Africa: High economic, demographic and urban growth rates
- Current Access levels to power (47 %), water (63 %). Communication (20 %) and quality transport infrastructure
- Road Sector Needs: Africa as a continent depending on cross-border trade (mostly landlocked)
- Role of Infrastructure Mobility in Economic and Social Growth: Lack of Infr. sharps of 2 % of per capital growth
- Importance in achieving the SDCs: Infrastructure as production input
