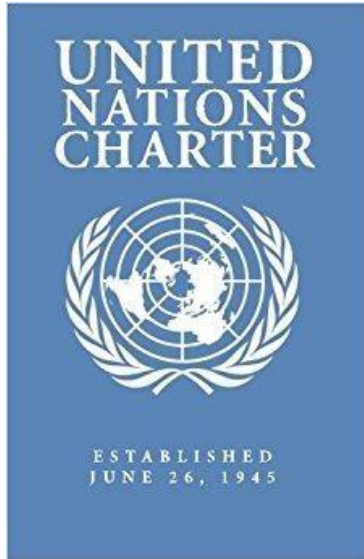

- ▶ The right to enjoy the benefits of science and its applications
- ▶ The right of all people to education and information

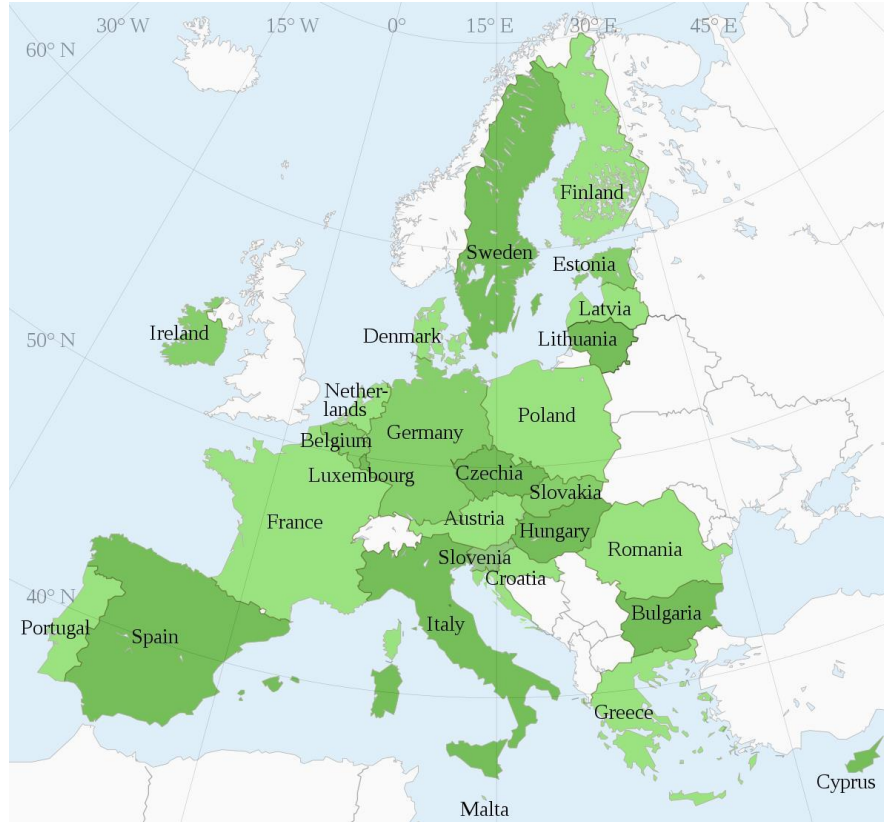
